KINDERGARTEN STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- 4 pocket folders (home, classroom, 1 for Health, 1 for Music)
- Small pair of scissors-label
- 2-3 pencils with eraser *pencils are supplied for classroom use
- 1 large, loose pink eraser (**no shape erasers**)-can label with initials
- Crayons (max of 24)*students are given a set of 8 crayons
- Glue sticks (1 pkg)-I will have a communal container of all glue sticks for students to share
- Washable broad tip markers (max of 10)-1 package only
- Zippered pouch/bag (6"x9" work best) Please- no plastic pencil boxes (tend to break/crack)
- A small towel (child size) for rest time-needs to be labeled (no blankets or sleeping bags)
- Paint smock or large shirt (with sleeves) should cover-up most of the body-label
- Backpack: should be able to hold a 10"x18" envelope (weekly school news)-label inside the backpack with your child's full name
- Lunch bag/box -label inside with child's full name and rm. #, thermos should also be labeled
- 1 box of Kleenex for classroom use, 1 pkg of paper towels
- 1 container of personal/baby body wipes for classroom use
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes for classroom use

Please bring all of these items to school with your child on their first day of school. It is important that your child's name is labeled on items that will not be shared. Requests for replenishments will be sent throughout the year as needed. Special items may be requested.

FIRST GRADE STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- One pencil bag or pouch. Pencils, crayons, glue and scissors should be able to fit in your child's pencil bag/pouch. If items do not fit they will be sent home. Please – no pencil boxes.
- Markers and colored pencils should be placed in a separate Ziploc bag. They will be put into a classroom box.
- SMALL box of crayons (24 count).
- 1 small pair scissors
- 1 box WASHABLE broad tipped markers (8 or 10 count) – **Crayola** preferred in a separate Ziploc bag with your child's name on the bag.
- Glue sticks – 10. We will put all glue in a container and I will ask that it be restocked throughout the year. No dollar store – **Elmer's** preferred.
- 6-10 pencils, #2, sharpened
- 12 count colored pencils, sharpened
- 3 folders (2 pocket style). Label them as: Take Home, Health, Music
- 2 boxes of Kleenex for classroom use.
- 1 yellow highlighter.
- Trapper keepers and binders are NOT permitted. They are too big to fit in the desk and are too heavy to carry.
- 10 **fine black** dry erase markers (EXPO Brand)
- 2 large pink erasers
- NO pencil sharpeners
- 100 index cards (3 ½ x 5)
- 1 container wipes
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- **A-M** Quart Size Ziploc Bags
- **N-Z** Gallon Size Ziploc Bags

SECOND GRADE STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

***If you are new to East Catholic**, you will need one black and white composition book for a science notebook.

- 5 pocket folders
- 6 - #2 pencils
- Colored pencils (12 count)
- Crayons (24 count - maximum)
- 1 pair scissors
- Markers (washable 8 count, broad point)
- Glue sticks (6)
- Pencil bag with zipper – must hold all supplies except markers (no plastic pencil boxes)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 2 boxes Kleenex for classroom use
- 1 container of pop-up baby wipes (refill pack is OK)
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (pump type)
- 1 box snack size Ziploc bags (A-H)
- 1 box sandwich size Ziploc bags (I-R)
- 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags (S-Z)
- 1 container Clorox/Lysol wipes
- NO pencil sharpeners

*With a permanent marker, please put your child's name or initials on all items in the event the items become misplaced during the course of the school day.

THIRD GRADE STUDENTS SUPPLY LIST

- 4 marble composition notebooks (100 pages and sewn together). NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS PLEASE (wires are unsafe)
- 1 Accordion folder (10 or more pockets)
- 2 packages of WIDE RULED (not college ruled) loose leaf
- Several #2 pencils, sharpened
- Colored pencils
- Crayons (NOT larger than 16 count)
- 1 Container Huggies Unscented or Cucumber Melon scent diaper wipes
- Scissors
- 4 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white glue
- Blue or black erasable pens (optional)
- 1 Material pencil pouch with zipper, (approx. 5x8", must be small enough to fit in the desk (NOT hard plastic pencil boxes)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of Lysol (not Clorox) wipes
- 1 box (quart size) Ziploc bags (those with last names A-J)
- 1 box (sandwich size) Ziploc bags (those with last names K-R)
- 1 box (gallon size) Ziploc bags (those with the last names S-Z)
- Trapper keepers and binders are NOT permitted. They are too big to fit in the desk and are too heavy to carry.

All pencil case items must be able to fit into ONE pencil case, with the exception of the glue bottle. If they do not fit, then narrow them down to less crayons and colored pencils.

Spiral notebooks are not permitted because the wires are unsafe.

Please label your child's accordion folder and notebooks before the first day of school. Label a pocket in the accordion folder with each of the following: Home, School, Religion, Math, English, Reading, Phonics, Science, and Social Studies. The notebooks should be: Math, English/Journal, Science, and Social Studies. Please be sure to write your child's name on all folders and notebooks.

FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADE STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- Headphones for classroom use on Tablets
- 1 Accordion folder (plastic) with 6-10 pockets
- 8 – composition notebooks (sewn type, *NO spiral notebooks please*)
- 1 – plastic folder with NO prongs
- 2 packages of wide ruled loose leaf paper – 1 for classroom use
- 2 – pocket folders (plastic or coated types last longer)
- #2 pencils (6 or more) and erasers
- Blue or black Erasable pens (3 or more)
- Red pens (2 or more)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- Colored pencils or crayons – 24 count or less
- Markers (set of 8-10) (*No permanent markers*)
- Index cards (set of 100 or more)
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Pencil case with zipper (NO pencil boxes)
- 8 Book covers (paper or fabric but NOT adhesive types)
- 2 Boxes of facial tissues for classroom (i.e. Kleenex, Puffs)
- 1 Container of disinfecting wipes (i.e. Clorox, Lysol) or paper towels
- 1 Bottle hand sanitizer (scent-free) for classroom use
- 2 Dry erase markers (black or blue) *Scent free*
- 1 Box of resealable plastic bags (any size for classroom use)
- NOTE: Trapper Keepers and binders are NOT permitted. Many styles are simply too large to fit in desks or lockers.

Also, remember that certain items should be available for home use. Items like a dictionary and thesaurus may be needed to complete homework. It is helpful to stock basic supplies like loose leaf, markers, pens and pencils so that these items do not have to be transported in the book bag where they can be damaged. Don't forget to have a stapler and pencil sharpener at home. If large quantities are purchased, bring in the listed quantity and leave the rest at home. Students often "give away" their extras and then run out too soon. Also, there is not extra storage room in the lockers or the items become damaged or forgotten.

Please try to label all of your child's belongings with permanent ink, frequently missed items are pencil cases and lunch bags. Student names should be recorded neatly in the box designated in each text book. All books should be covered within a week of receiving them. Label each book cover. Labeled items will typically find their way back to their owner. Remember to check your child's book bag for papers from school. Family envelopes will be sent home every Wednesday. There may be forms that need to be completed in a timely fashion. Envelopes should be returned every Friday.

UPPER GRADE SUPPLY LIST (Grades 6-8)

Language Arts (Reading/English/Spelling), Mathematics
Science, Social Studies, Religion, Study Skills

- Single subject notebook for each class (Composition style – no spiral rings). **English** and **Reading** should have individual notebooks. **Spelling** work will be done in the reading notebook. **No large binders.**
- #2 pencils with erasers for daily use.
- Colored pencils/crayons/markers
- Fine point markers
- 2 Black Dry erase markers (all Math groups)
- Glue sticks
- Red pens*, blue or black pens (*at least 5 red pens*)
- Folder with pockets for **each** class, or an accordion folder with pockets to be labeled for each class.
- Calculator – an inexpensive basic calculator *with a square root function* is sufficient for our purposes.
- Several packs of wide ruled loose leaf paper to be used in all classes

SPANISH

- Box of Kleenex

Required for daily Spanish Class:

- A composition notebook designated for Spanish
- A pocket folder or space in accordion folder for all classes
- A package of loose leaf paper
- A highlighter
- A dry erase marker and eraser
- Pencils, erasers, black, blue, and red pens

Optional:

A paperback Spanish/English dictionary – I prefer this over Google translate because often there are words with multiple meanings in English, as well as multiple words in Spanish for one word in English. Digital translators don't always discriminate.

Notecards and rubber bands or plastic cases for making flashcards. Some may prefer to make foldables or use apps such as Quizlet or Duo lingo to practice vocabulary.

Items needed quarterly for projects (only bring to class when assignment is being done)

- Sharpie Markers, colored pencils, crayons, and/or markers
- Glue Sticks
- Scissors
- Poster Paper
- Catalogues, advertisements, magazines, etc. for photos-these are much cheaper than computer ink!
